Farmland Preservation Tax: "Farmland Preservation Committee":

Lehigh County Preservation Board provided a list of the 6 farms in Heidelberg Township that are potential farms for preservation.

A motion was made by David Fink to pay the total amount over the County's maximum payment allowance amount for the current farms brought forth by the Lehigh County Preservation Board. The motion was lost due to no second.

A motion was made by Steven Bachman, seconded by Jonathan Jakum to pay up to a maximum of \$1,000.00 per acre over the County's maximum payment allowance for the current 6 farms up for preservation brought forth

by the Lehigh County Preservation Board to total \$135,010.00 as the highest payout amount for the year. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Steven Bachman, seconded by Jonathan Jakum to appoint Christine "Teena" Bailey to the Farmland preservation committee. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Steven Bachman, seconded by Jonathan Jakum to adopt Resolution #2024-34 appointing David Fink, Resolution #2024-35 appointing Aimee Good, Resolution #2024-36 appointing William Dietrich, Resolution #2024-37 appointing Benjamin Wise, Resolution #2024-38 appointing Matthew Schneider, and Resolution #2024-39 appointing Christine "Teena" Bailey to serve on the Farmland Preservation Committee. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Steven Bachman, seconded by Jonathan Jakum to schedule a Special Meeting on December 30th at 4:00pm to review the Potato Barn roof options, a generator for the township municipal building, and a site inspection for the new public works building and a public hearing for the proposed Ordinance # 2024-5 Zoning Ordinance and Map Amendments adoption.
